

AFL HUNTER CENTRAL COAST RECRUITMENT & MARKETING POLICY

The AFL NSW/ACT Development Team, in consultation with the AFL Hunter Central Coast Clubs, has developed the recruitment and marketing zone for each club. This designates which schools a club may be active in, to drive recruitment within their club.

- Within the designated club Recruiting Zones, clubs are able to, but not limited to, do the following:
 - School assembly visits.*
 - School newsletter advertisements.*
 - Shopping centre promotions and registration days.
 - Distribution of club flyers.*
 - Install banners, posters, signage, in appropriate locations.
 - o Encourage parents to talk with other parents about their children joining their club.
 - Work with other sports, to promote AFL as a winter and/or Sunday sporting option.
 - Newspaper advertisements.

*Clubs wishing to visit local schools must first contact the AFL NSWACT Development Team, to ensure consistency of messaging, and level of contact made to the school previously.

- Clubs who are found to have promoted themselves using any of the methods above in areas outside of their recruiting zone may be fined by the AFL Hunter Central Coast Board, up to \$500.
- Clubs are expected to remind any potential new registration of the location of their local club, should that player not be registering at their nearest club.
- Solicitation of transfer: A club, its management, coaches, player, parents or any other person
 directly or indirectly involved in a club must not solicit a player registered with another club with a
 view to having a player move to another club. Clubs found guilty of engaging in this practice will be
 subject to sanction from AFL Hunter Central Coast. Clubs must make all stakeholders involved in
 their club that this practice is unacceptable.
