

LEAGUE INTERCHANGE AGREEMENT



This is an agreement between AFL Sydney and AFL Hunter Central Coast for the movement of players between the respective leagues pursuant to the AFL NSW/ACT Regulations and the National Player Transfer Regulations (the Agreement).

1.0 Definitions and Background

- 1.1 Terms capitalised have the same meaning as in the AFL NSW/ACT Regulations.
- 1.2 This Agreement is in force for the 2020 season only. Copies to be distributed to each League and Club involved in the permit system.
- 1.3 The purpose of this agreement is provide Players from regional areas with some additional development opportunities and not to be used as a mechanism to improve team performance.

2.0 Administrative Processes

- 2.1 The Leagues' agree to the following procedures with respect to all Local Interleague Permits.
- 2.2 The Clubs will use a 'Local Interchange' permit on the SportingPulse/Footyweb system to lodge the Player permits.
- 2.3 Both Clubs involved must agree to the Players playing on the day in question with the relative Club.
- 2.4 Players can only be registered with one Club to utilise the permit system.
- 2.5 The permit of all Players under this Agreement must be approved by the Football Operations Manager of the respective Leagues.

3.0 Permit Rules

- 3.1 A Player is only permitted to play with one Club on any weekend or round.
- 3.2 A Player may only be granted a permit to one (1) AFL Sydney/AFL Hunter Central Coast Club per Season.
- 3.3 Clubs may have a maximum of two (2) permit players for each match.
- 3.4 Permits are only eligible to be used for matches no later than 31st July.
- 3.5 Matches played on permit do not count towards finals eligibility with either Club, unless the Player is permanently transferred to the interchange Club.

4.0 Reported Players

- 4.1 If a Player who is playing on a permit is reported, the Player shall face the Tribunal of the League of which the reportable offence was committed in accordance with the relevant League By-Laws.
- 4.2 Any penalty that is imposed by the League Tribunal will apply to all AFL managed or affiliated competitions.


5.0 Approval


