AFL NSW/ACT CODE OF CONDUCT

Each Parent and Supporter understands and agrees to:

- Support the participants and enjoy the Match;
- Encourage participation, but don't force it;
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning;
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses;
- Lead by example and respect all Players, Coaches, Umpires, Officials and spectators. Physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated;

- Never publicly criticise Umpires and instead raise personal concerns with Club Officials in private;
- Do not use remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability as many such comments are politically incorrect and it is your Coach, team-mates, Club and family that are let down with such remarks;
- Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing Clubs;
- Do not engage in physical and/or verbal intimidation, abuse or conduct toward any Player, Official, Umpire or supporter. Such actions are totally unacceptable;
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by spectators, Coaches, Officials or Players;
- Refrain from using abusive language.
- Not to enter the field of play in any sanctioned Competition Match unless granted permission by an Official to do so;
- Not take part in any form of bullying including via the use of social media;
- Not make or post inappropriate, offensive or discriminatory comments in public, including via social media, about Players, Clubs, Umpires, Officials, the AFL or the League. Social media includes, but is not limited to, email, instant messaging, text messages, phone messages, digital images, website postings (including social media such as Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Instagram, websites and blogs);

CANOBIE, BAILEY FIRE BOMBERS INTO FIRST AT TURNING POINT OF AFL BLACK DIAMOND CUP WOMENS SEASON

Killarney Vale came out ahead of Newcastle City in an unmissable top-spot clash.

Killarney Vale have won the first scintillating battle for the AFL Black Diamond Cup Women's minor premiership, edging three-time defending champs Newcastle City with 11 goals to six in their highly-anticipated sixth-round meeting. The Bombers and the Blues have been the teams to watch this season, not least due to the fact they both fired to 5-0 starts once the belated 2020 AFL Hunter Central Coast season finally got underway in July.

The two heavyweights meeting on August 22 could well have been a grand final rematch, but for the AFLHCC draw matching them up in the 2019 semi-finals. The Bombers — [tipped as favourites for the flag last year](#) — had their barnstorming season cut short by the ever-illustrious Blues. Killarney Vale had to watch from the sideline as Newcastle clinched their third Hunter Central Coast title in a row.

And so, all eyes were on the two contenders as they met in Round 6. Both sides had been perfect up to this point results-wise. Whoever won at Adelaide Street Oval would be in the lead in the standings, and boast the early mental edge to boot. The clash delivered too. Skye Bailey got the Bombers off to an early 12-nil lead, but City recruit Amy Pittman kicked one back just five minutes in. Kristen Kessler, who would go on to kick two for the Bombers, struck late for an 18-6 split in the first.

The two clubs traded blows again in the second quarter, with Bailey adding her third for a first-half hat-trick. Claire Mcgarity and Annalise Norton were about to strike back for the Newcastle squad, and City found themselves trailing by just a 16 point margin as the half time whistle called for a well-earned break.

The Bombers were able to wrestle the game into their favour in the second half, firing home five majors to Newcastle's three. City strike-weapon Sarah Halvorsen opened the contest again early with a goal in the 16th minute of the third, splitting the difference to eight, but Killarney Vale was all class as they answered with four in a row.

Halvorsen and Pittman both chalked doubles for the defeated Blues, while Taylah Canobie shot in two late goals to join Bailey with a hat-trick haul at Adelaide Street Oval.

City's 30-point loss locks them on 20 competition points so far in 2020, and keeps them on a five-win, one-loss record. The Bombers jump a win ahead, giving them that breathing room atop the AFL Hunter Central Coast totem pole, for now.

The Newcastle loss also opened the door for Cardiff to spring into the top-three mix. The Hawks kept Wyong Lakes from scoring a major as they edged them 42-1 at Northlakes Oval, and moved alongside City on 20 points.

Tayla Gregory was the standout forward for the third-place squad, shooting home three in the Round 6 clash. Nikki Standen, Eloise Petersen, and Abbey Cooksley also added a goal apiece, while Clare Cummings was named best on field.

Also in the sixth round, Maitland scored their first win of the season with a win over the combined Nelson Bay-Port Stephens outfit, while Terrigal Avoca waved away a Warners Bay challenge at Hylton Moore Oval. Jasmine Mandy led the way for the Panthers.

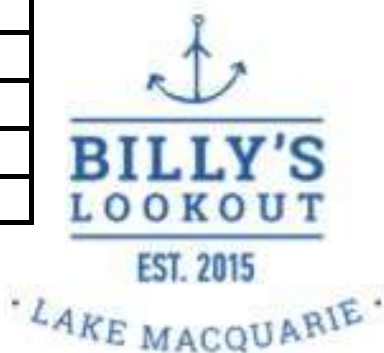
