**Each Parent and Supporter understands and agrees to:**

- Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing Clubs;
- Do not engage in physical and/or verbal intimidation, abuse or conduct toward any Player, Official, Umpire or supporter. Such actions are totally unacceptable;
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, whether it is by spectators, Coaches, Officials or Players;
- Refrain from using abusive language.
- Not to enter the field of play in any sanctioned Competition Match unless granted permission by an Official to do so;
- Not take part in any form of bullying including via the use of social media;
- Not make or post inappropriate, offensive or discriminatory comments in public, including via social media, about Players, Clubs, Umpires, Officials, the AFL or the League. Social media includes, but is not limited to, email, instant messaging, text messages, phone messages, digital images, website postings (including social media such as Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Instagram, websites and blogs);

## PANTHERS CONSOLIDATE BLACK DIAMOND CUP TOP FOUR SPOT WITH ON-THE-ROAD VICTORY OVER SAINTS

*Terrigal Avoca have made finals theirs to lose after a 4–3 start to the season.*

Terrigal Avoca have put themselves in the driver's seat for finals ahead of the AFL Black Diamond Cup run-in, after Morgan Ross and Gabrielle Ralphs kicked ten between them to down last year's runners-up Maitland in a key 71–17 victory.

Ross got the victory off to a flying start in the first quarter, shooting the Panthers to a 19–0 lead at Max McMahon Oval. The top-four team capitalised on Ross' first-quarter hat-trick with three more, including one for Erin Wakefield, and two for Ralphs.

The Magpies have been nipping at Terrigal's heels in recent weeks, but their 70-point loss to the league leaders halts any upward momentum they were hoping to achieve ahead of the run-in. They now sit two wins behind the Panthers.

Their loss also puts them within striking distance of Warners Bay and Maitland, though both teams suffered losses this round. The Saints, as mentioned above, lost to the Panthers and the Bulldogs were downed by Newcastle City away from home.

The Blues opened fire at Warners Bay early at No.1 Sportsground after losing the battle for first last weekend. Giants' AFLW star Sarah Halvorsen was the lead shooter in the Round 7 salvo, slotting home four alongside former Bulldog Amy Pittman.

Warners Bay gave a good account of themselves in the loss too, with number seventeen Tracy Baker-Holmes finding the mark three times in the team's 87-point defeat.

Finally, Cardiff fired off a warning shot to the rest of the competition with a hefty 185-point scoreline against the Nelson Bay-Port Stephens combined outfit. The win keeps the Hawks level with rivals Newcastle City ahead of their clash next weekend.

Minerva Bailey and Tayla Gregory led the way for the home side at Cameron Park on Saturday, kicking six and five. Clare Clummings also chipped in to the lopsided score with a hat-trick. Sophie Rankin and Hayley Hawkins both scored twice.

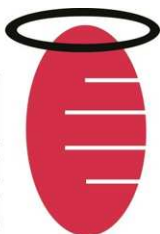

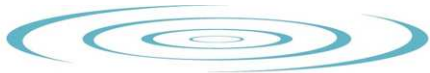

Colin Goodenough will become the first Boundary Umpire in history of the NCCUA to reach 250 Black Diamond Cup matches as a Boundary Umpire this weekend.

Goodenough's achievement in umpiring 250 Black Diamond Cup matches has only been achieved on 2 other occasions: Darrel Luck leads the group on 334 Cup matches (331 field – 3 boundary) and John Sullivan on 258 matches (6 field, 252 goal).

Colin commenced umpiring in 2006 and, along with his patented headband, has not missed a year since. Goodenough has officiated in 333 matches, the fourth highest total in NCCUA history and 314 BDAFL matches as a Boundary Umpire.

His tally includes; 250 Cup, 22 Plate, 10 Second Division, 10 Reserve Grade, 17 Under 18's and 5 Women's Matches. Colin's other 19 matches come as a Goal Umpire.

Colin's Grand Finals include: 2 Black Diamond Cup Grand Finals (2007, 2008); 3 Black Diamond Plate Grand Finals (2012, 2013, 2017); 2 Second Division Grand Finals (2014, 2016), 2 Reserve Grade Grand Finals (2010, 2011), 1 Under 18's Grand Final (2006) and the Inaugural BDAFL Women's Grand Final (2015).

Colin has also officiated in two representative fixtures: 2008 Under 18's and 2009 First Grade. Along with his wife, Rachel, the Goodenough family have officiated in a whopping 562 BDAFL matches! The NCCUA congratulate and thank Colin for his continued services to umpiring and wish him all the very best for his historic appearance in the AFL Hunter Central Coast Football League.
