While this is not statistically significant, it does mean that Colin has now moved into second place on the NCCUA's all time Black Diamond Cup games list. Colin has now surpassed NCCUA Legend John Sullivan.

Included in Colin's 259 Black Diamond Cup Men's matches are 17 BDC Finals matches (2 Black Diamond Cup Grand Finals) and even one Black Diamond Cup match as a Goal Umpire.

We congratulate Colin on this achievement and thank him, and his wife Rachel, for their continued service to umpiring.

The NCCUA this week also sees an umpire make his Black Diamond Cup Men's debut as a Field Umpire. Brad Egan becomes the 139th Field Umpire to achieve this feat since the 2000 season. Congrats and best of luck Brad.

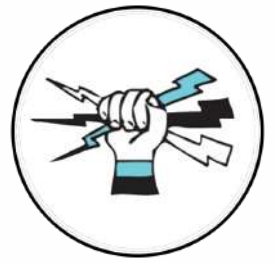

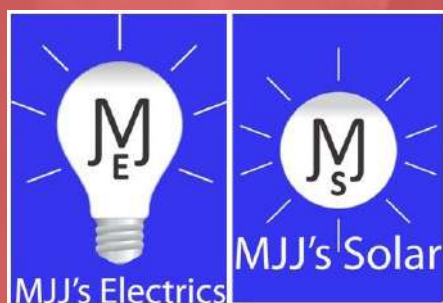

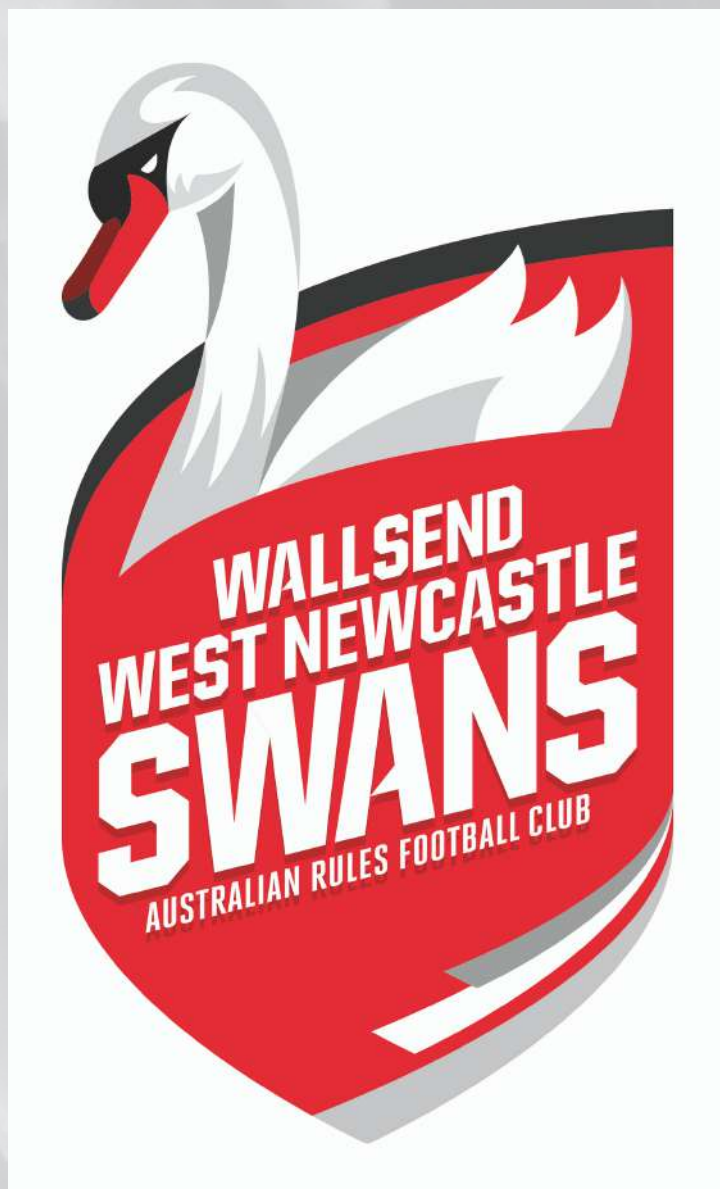
