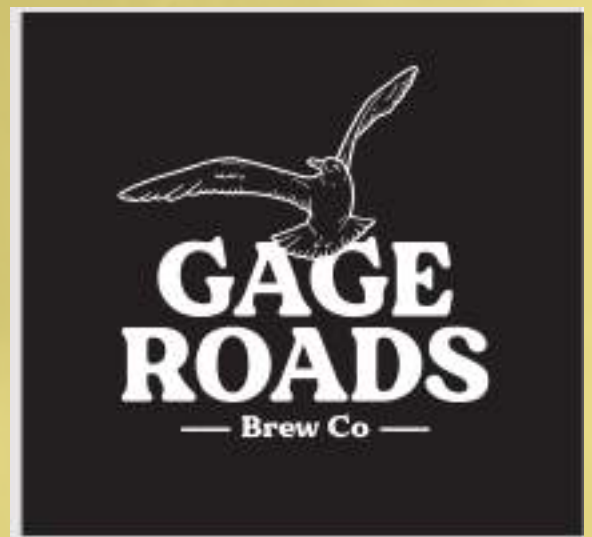

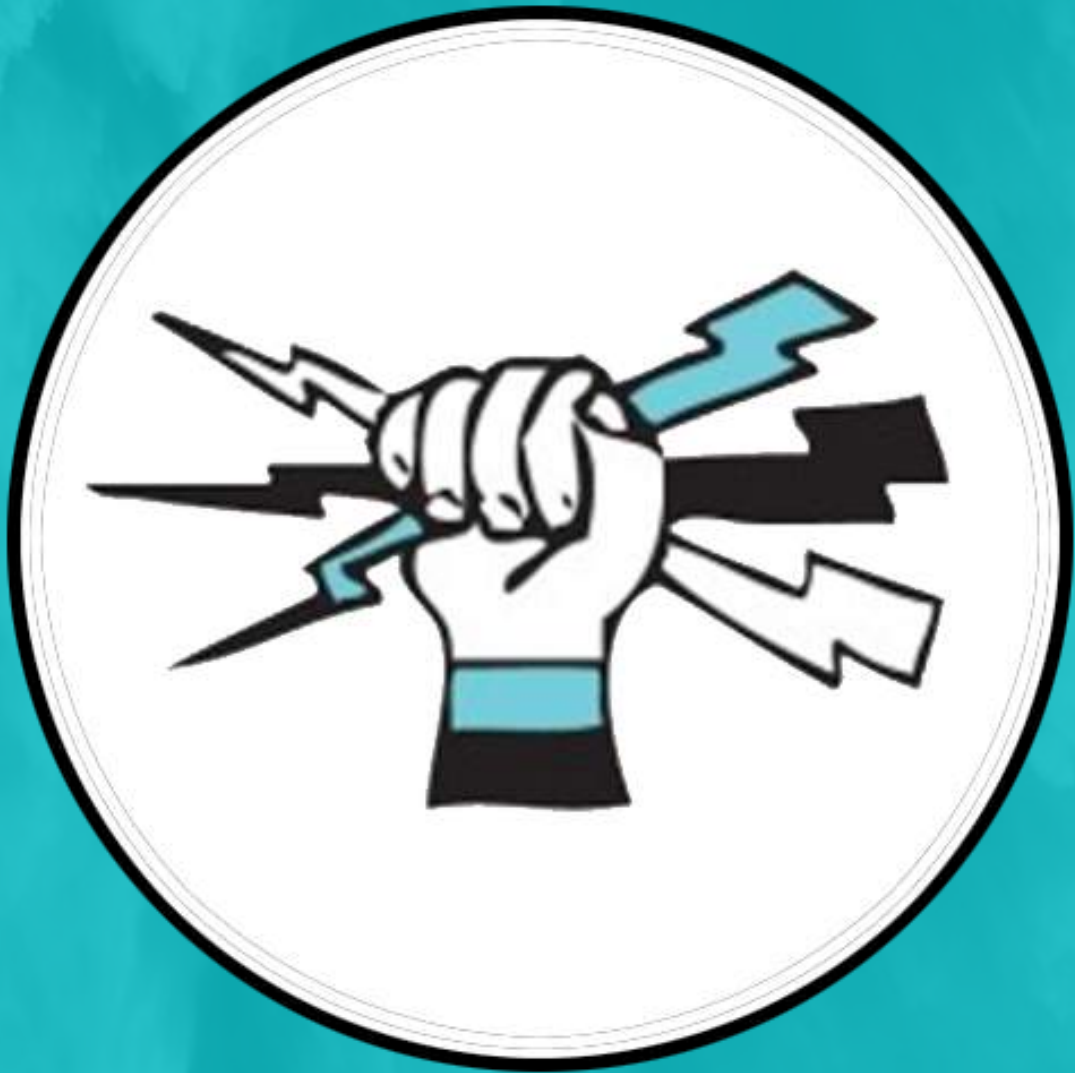
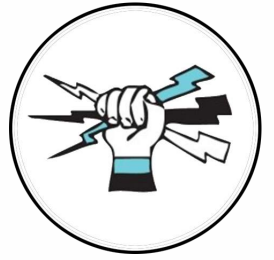

He has won a senior premiership, captained the AFLHCC representative line-up and taken home an Elliott Davey medal.

Now Andrew Scott has joined the Singleton Roosters' 100 game club after he was chaired off the field against Maitland Saints at Rose Point Park last week.

Not even the 99-point deficit could deter fans from praising the club's former captain and coach such has been his legacy to the club since joining in 2016.

"I have seen players from 2008 onwards, he is in my eyes the best to ever play for the Singleton Roosters and probably will be until either of his sons knock him off (if they play for the Roosters)," teammate Alex Mitchell playfully explained.

"It's been a privilege to play alongside him and learn from him on the field but also massively off the field, the way he goes about life and footy; it's pretty to watch."

Scott, who co-captained the Queensland under-21 side in 2007, also played 100+ games for Mount Gravatt prior to his Singleton career.

There he captained the Vultures for two seasons and claimed a coveted Jim Fletcher medal in 2013.

Scott also played a season with WAFL club Subiaco in 2010.

"He (Scott) sits right at the top for Singleton," Macpherson explained.

"He is the best player I've played with and seen in my time at the Roosters.

"My fondest memory would be obviously winning the premiership in 2016 but getting to a prelim a couple of years later in the top league and being only two kicks away from making the grand final is a close second.

"It was his first year as coach and to see firsthand what he was able to produce on the field and coach at the same time was pretty special."

Scott was named in his side's best players alongside acting captain and fellow Queenslander Cameron White.

White, who is also closing in on the club's 100-game mark, believes Scott will go down as one of the Roosters' best players of the modern era.

"Through the footy he's played for Singleton and Hunter Rep, I don't think too many people would argue against him being the best player in the league over the last five years," White added.

"Through his on-field efforts and time given to the club as player coach, he should be recognised as a driving force for the men's team successfully making the jump up to the Cup competition."

Earlier in the day, Scott's wife Lynan inspired her women's side to a 17.14 (116) to 0.0 (0) win over Maitland.

The Singleton line-ups will now play host to Newcastle City this Saturday. MEANWHILE junior AFL will also return to the Upper Hunter this Sunday when the Singleton Roosters play a number of opposing clubs.

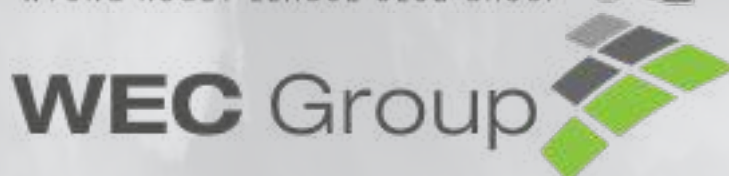
