The NCCUA need to congratulate the following umpires who have achieved milestones in the last two weeks:

- Shane Lowndes 50 Womens Matches as a goal;
- Taj Barton Black Diamond Cup - Men's debut as a boundary;
- Jonah Finlay 50 matches overall;
- Scott Donnet 50 matches overall.

This week will see Shane Lowndes officiate in his 150th AFLHCC Match as a Goal Umpire. Included in this is 66 Black Diamond Cup - Men's and over 50 Women's matches.

If this list of milestones were not impressive enough this week we will also see a major milestone when Darrel Luck walks out to umpire the Killarney Vale v Warners Bay Black Diamond Cup - Men's Match. Darrel, who is an NCCUA & AFLHCC Life Member and a current Field Umpire Coach, will officiate in his 350th Black Diamond Cup - Men's Match as a Field Umpire. Included in Darrel's 350 Cup Matches is 31 appearances in Cup Finals matches, and 6 Black Diamond Cup Grand Finals. It is important to note that this milestone only includes the Men's Cup matches that Darrel has run since the formation of the BDAFL in 2000, so it doesn't include any First Grade matches that he ran in the Central Coast comp.

350 Cup matches is a record in the NCCUA that we doubt anyone else will go close to matching in the next decade if ever. We offer a massive congratulations and best wishes to Darrel for his milestone match on Saturday and thank him for his continuing service to umpiring, the NCCUA and to footy in our region.
