Sir Doug Nicholls Round provides an opportunity to celebrate Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, culture and history and the invaluable contributions Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples have made to AFL.

The following is a very special story behind Dave's magnificent artwork:

"This artwork depicts what I see what umpiring has done for me over the past 11 seasons as an umpire and the past 19 years while involved with football.

The artwork depicts three people which I see as a boundary umpire, a goal umpire and lastly a field umpire. Without these people we are unable to start the beautiful game of football. The depiction of the umpires show white lines on each of them, I see this as the history of umpiring with the old white uniforms as well as the growth that each umpire gets from every single game.

The line connecting all three umpires is the tracks of the serpent that created the hills and the rivers but also creates the fields that we play this beautiful sport on.

The lighter green lines in the background show the different land and country that we play football on every weekend. It depicts the hills and valleys that we travel through and over to watch the bounce at the start of the game.

The three gum leaves represent the change of season and how different the countries are in the Hunter Central Coast AFL."

Keep an eye out for this great shirt on Saturday and maybe even in future rounds where clubs are also wearing their Indigenous strips.

Cardiff Hawks celebrate Sir Doug Nicholls Round for the fifth year

The Cardiff Hawks AFL Club is throwing its support behind the AFL's annual Sir Doug Nicholls Round this weekend at Pasterfield Sports Complex.

The round celebrates Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and players, and their contribution to Australian football.

Warren Lovell, President of the Cardiff Hawks, is looking forward to this weekend's celebration. "Cardiff Hawks AFC are pleased and proud to be able to host a series of games this weekend at our Pasterfield Oval facility to celebrate the rich Indigenous heritage associated with our game," he said.

"This will be the fifth year we have put this day together with the help of the local Awabakal people."

Sir Doug Nicholls Round will be celebrated at the elite game across rounds 10 and 11 of the AFL, but community clubs in NSW and the ACT are welcome to acknowledge Indigenous culture and heritage whenever they feel they can manage a meaningful impact.

Warren Lovell was particularly proud of this year's celebrations at Cardiff. He said: "The Cardiff teams will wear special commemorative jumpers featuring Indigenous motifs, there will be Welcome to Country and smoking ceremony prior to the Cup men's game, along with face painting for the kids."

"The club sees this as a chance to acknowledge the invaluable role of the players and volunteers with Indigenous heritage, both within our club and across the community more broadly".

Cardiff will host Wallsend West Newcastle Swans in the AFL Hunter Central Coast's Black Diamond Plate Women's game at 10am, and the again in the Black Diamond Plate Men's game at 11:45am. Its Black Diamond Cup men's game against Maitland will kick off at 2pm, with a formal ceremony to take place just prior to this game.
