I had a look at the weather report today and the forecast was for sun. I can't quite believe that is right as it has been so long since we have seen it at Max McMahon but hopefully it means we get to play a game of footy at home this week. Time will tell.

The team lost by 10 points that day, the first time they had been able to be excited in six years, but as the final siren sounded and I stepped back onto the helicopter that had conveniently been left in the middle of the ground (they only paid me for the three hours), the thankful supporters surrounded the great bird and gave me a standing ovation as we rose into the sky.

What does that mean for us? Either someone has to kick 16 goals in each grade (look each other in the eye and set the challenge) or we continue to work together, support each other, and put in 100% effort in achieving the goals we set for ourselves and our team. In the Twos, I'm putting it on Bowlo. He clearly showed last week an uncanny goal sense and a monster right boot so our fate rests on him. The ladies and the Ones, without a Bowlo, will have to work together. We're at home boys and girls. IT will be a cracking day for footy. Get around each other and GO THE SAINTS!

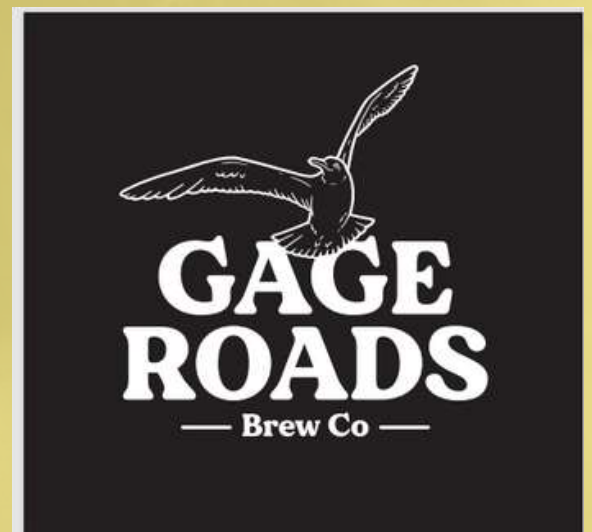

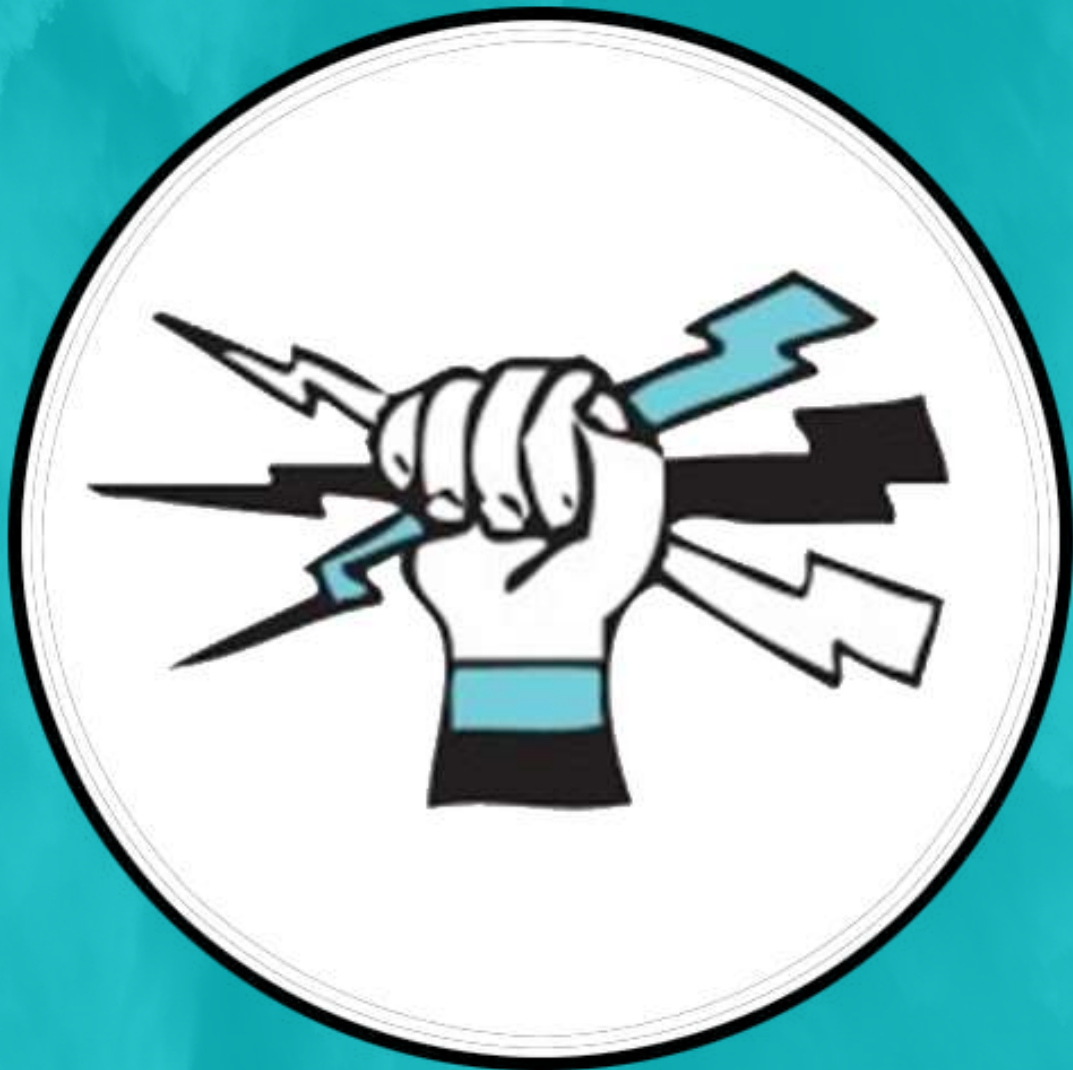
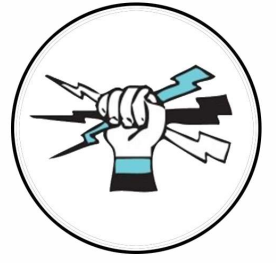
