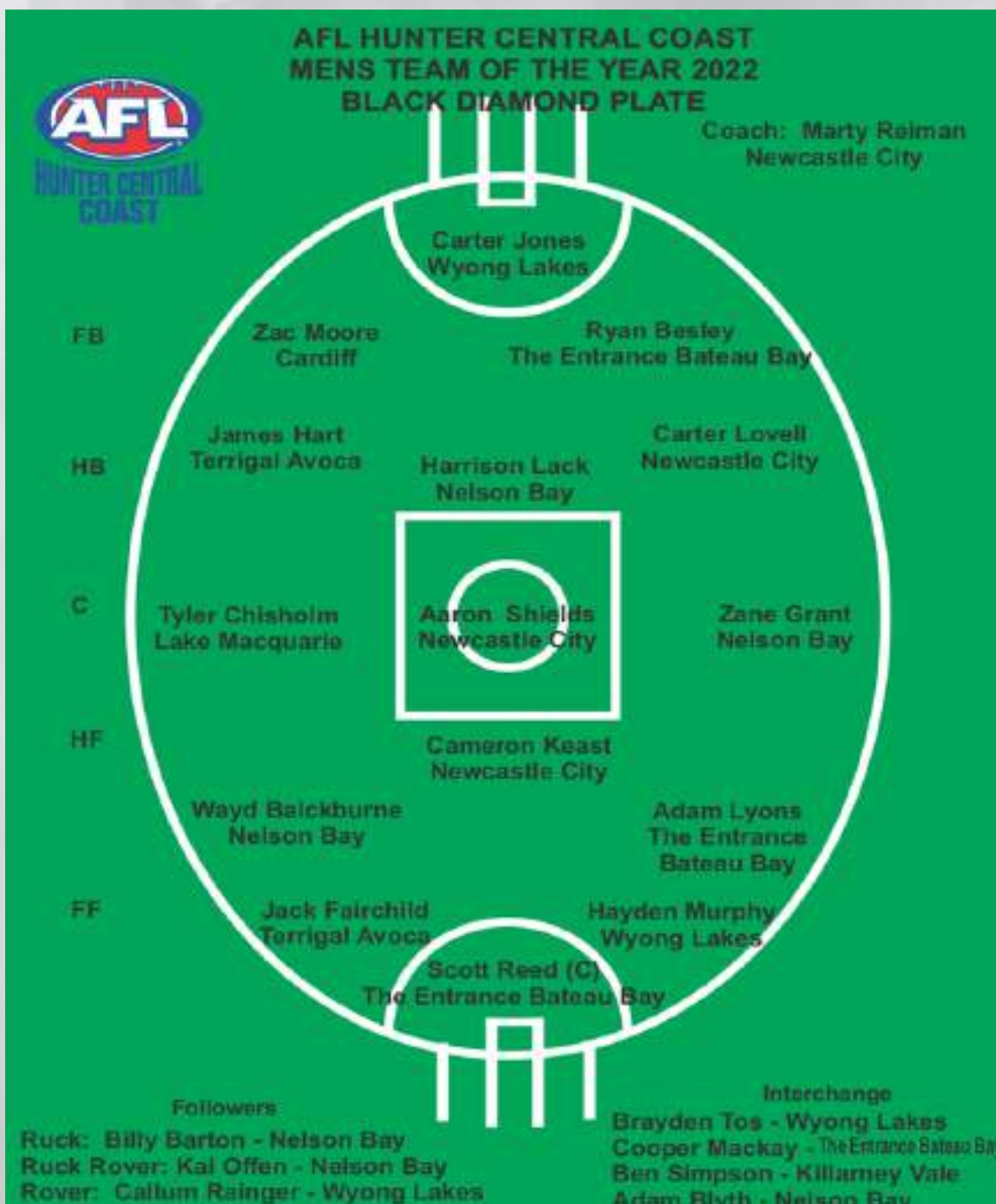

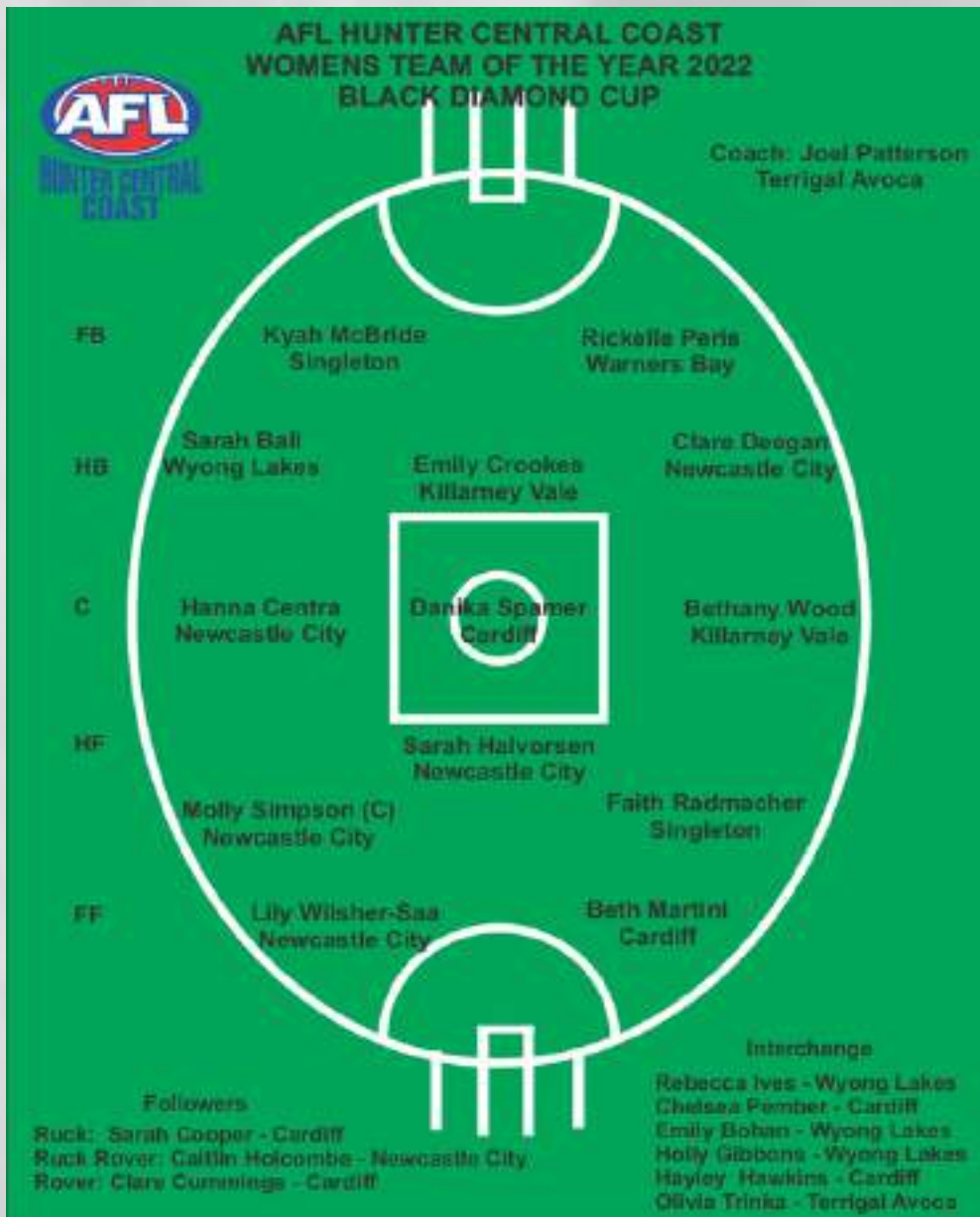

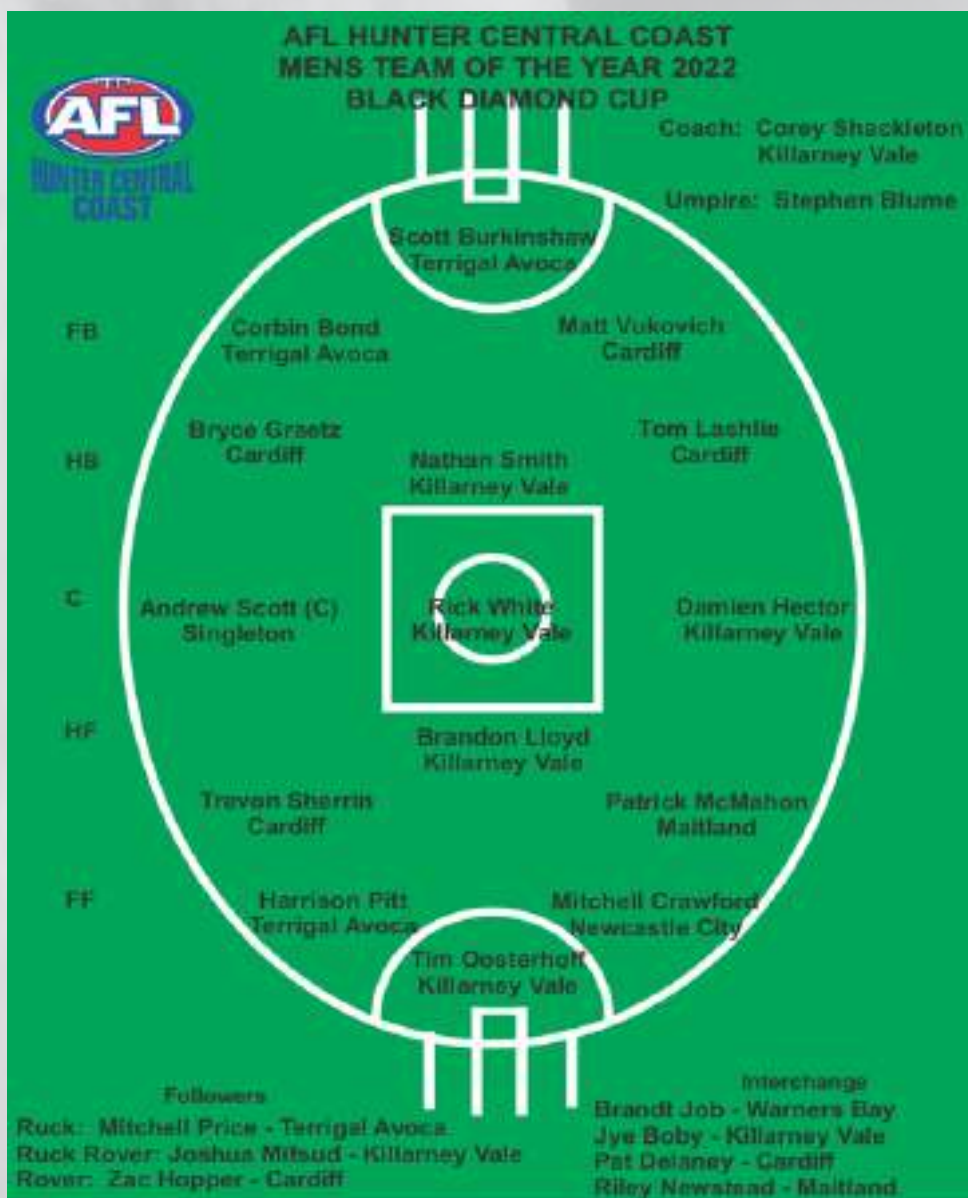

We encourage everyone to get out to the Grand Finals as we a sure there's still some fantastic footy to come.

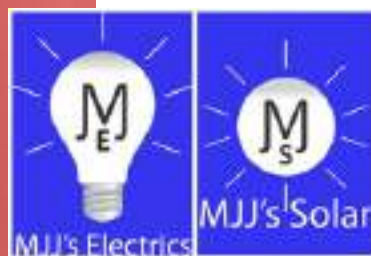
