The Umpire Talent Pathway consists of four tiers, starting with the introductory level – Next Gen Development. From there, umpires can progress through to Next Gen Advanced, VFL Accelerator, and finally, VFL Development, each level designed to support and prepare them for the next step in their journey.

The success of the Umpire Talent Pathway has been highlighted by a number of NSW/ACT umpires currently officiating at AFL level; including Field Umpire – Nic McGinness, Boundary umpires – Ben Fely, Dan Field Read, David Wood & Michael Barlow and Goal Umpires – Angus Mckenzie Wills, Alex Chisholm & Taylor Mattioli. The Northern NSW Representative Carnival is one that all officials, players, coaches and volunteers look forward to each and every year. Three massive days of footy are about to take over Coffs Harbour as the best young talent from across four proud regions come together to play for the Simon Smyth Cup.

From July 8 to 10, the Representative Carnival will showcase potential stars of the future within age groups U13, U15, and U17s with both boys and youth girls pulling on their regional colours and going head-to-head. This year's carnival will again be played across two quality venues: C.ex International Stadium and Sport & Leisure Park, adding to the atmosphere. Fierce but friendly rivalry is to expected between teams from:

- AFL Hunter Central Coast (fielding 15 teams)
- AFL North Coast (all age groups)
- AFL South Coast (all age groups)
- AFL North West (U13s only)

For the players, it's an exciting chance to represent their home region, connect with teammates from other clubs, and put their footy skills to the test on a bigger stage.

Whether you're a family member, a footy tragic (like myself), or just love seeing rising stars in action; this is a carnival not to miss.

Brad Greenshields; Community Football and Competition Manager for AFL Northern NSW, cited that in 2024 the event saw 27 teams play for their program with around 600 players in total playing in 81 matches across the 3 days. It featured 120 coaches, managers and umpires as well as approximately 1,200 spectators each day, showing how the event can bring a large section of the state's footy community to the region.

Designed and written by myself with many contributors from other regions, this record is your souvenir of the carnival; featuring line-ups, fixtures, activities and key information all in one place.

Whatever region you're from, whatever team you're supporting, I hope you have the most enjoyable representative carnival experience.



## THE SIMON SMYTH





When the three days of matches at the Northern NSW Championships have been finished, the region that has won the highest percentage of its matches across all of the age groups will be declared the winner of the Simon Smyth Cup.

For the past two years the trophy has been claimed by Illawarra (South Coast) in what are typically close run affairs.

The trophy was named after Simon Smyth, an experienced AFL staff member, who has been a pioneer for more than a decade in growing junior football across the Northern NSW region and has been and continues to be a champion for junior representative football and the benefits it provides for young players.

The honour was bestowed upon him prior to the 2022 edition of the Championships.

There are no winners declared across each individual age group.

The "winner" of the Championship will be the representative program that has the highest match ratio (percentage of wins from matches played) combined across all teams entered by that representative program.

The nickname for the AFL North Coast's representative teams has never been more apt.

The North Coast is fast becoming a Force to be reckoned with.

Each year over the past few years the AFL North Coast's junior representative teams have provided a better standard of football than the year before.

A major factor behind the improvement is the increased player numbers in the junior ranks.

In a competition that spans from Port Macquarie in the south up to Yamba in the north, the number of junior players in the region has grown by more than 50 per cent over the past three years. The introduction in that period of time of two additional girls only age groups as well as a non-competitive age group for those transitioning from Auskick to competitive footy has seen the numbers blossom.

Hopes are now high that the Force boys and girls will provide another strong showing at the 2025 Northern NSW Championships.

This year marks a significant milestone for the AFL North West's junior representative program.

There hasn't been a Blue Heelers junior representative team play since before COVID but this year with an Under 13 Boys team taking to the field, the AFL North West juniors can once again test themselves against strong opposition.

This year the junior competition in the North West has taken on a new guise with junior matches only being played once every three weeks in a Gala Day format.

Designed to overcome the long distances families are required to travel to and from the region's towns, teams play multiple matches each Gala Day while limiting the amount of time families are required to spend in a car.

The move looks to have paid off with junior participation numbers in 2025 up a massive 45 percent compared to last year.

This growth combined with the support of Regional Australia Bank, Squadron Energy and Gordon Barry & Co in Gunnedah means the Blue Heelers are now back and barking at the heels of the other Leagues playing at this year's Northern NSW Championships.






The program will target both male and female athletes in the following age groups:



# THE HISTORY OF C.EX INTERNATIONAL STADION COFFS HARBOUR

C.ex Coffs International Stadium, opened in 1994 and located in Coffs Harbour, is a premier multi-sport venue known for its high-quality grass surface and versatile facilities.

With a total capacity of 20 000 patrons and 3000 seats, it regularly hosts major sporting events including cricket, rugby league, AFL, and soccer. The stadium famously staged Australia's recordbreaking 31–0 win over American Samoa in a 2001 FIFA World Cup qualifier.

It has hosted Women's One Day Internationals in cricket, NRL trial matches, City vs Country Origin games, and annual Big Bash League (BBL) fixtures since 2021. AFL and AFLW matches have also featured at the ground, along with the FFA National Youth Championships.

The stadium is ideal for both day and night events, and also accommodates concerts and community functions, making it a key sporting and cultural hub for the Mid North Coast.
